From the President

It snowed on Ruapehu on May 1. That's always a good start to the season ... even if it did melt a lot the next day. Now the snowmails are coming in thick and fast, like the snow, we hope.

(Sign-up on snow-forecast.com, you get one resort permanent forecast free - it will send you a snowmail every time there is snow due)

I was up at Tukino doing a work party on 1 May – although I spent more time on TMCA. Everyone I saw there from Aorangi was working so hard, and I know there have been several other work parties in all the lodges – as usual in each lodge. Thanks a bunch everyone who has taken part. Its so beautiful up there and so isolated, it is a privilege to be able to visit, let alone stay. To that end I want to let you know (for friends who may want to join a club with one lodge up there), that there is a new club starting up to take over the old Christiana / OPC lodge. New members would be welcome there (contact TMCA for the people doing this, through tukino.co.nz.)

Also it looks like there will be cat skiing at Tukino soon! Its not known if it will get through all the hurdles this year, but after a long search (world-wide!) a spare vehicle has been found in Nelson on Rainbow skifield. Aorangi is supporting the DOC change to National Park Management Plan to allow over-snow transport. Note that this could include you getting an oversnow taxi to the Iwikau lodge door with your bags on a Friday night . Which is possibly more of an issue for clubs like Pinnacles! or National Downhill.

So as usual at this time of year the lodges are looking smart, Ohakune is a picture, Iwikau has a nearly new kitchen, and Tukino has some new windows and paint too. Ohakune is likely to get new kitchen equipment next year, and Tukino probably the year after. Food is in store for all the lodges. And one of the last things will be a new internal wireless network set up at Iwikau and Ohakune. Roll on Opening weekend.

Thank you to all those who answered our survey, giving us the benefit of your experience and time. With around 700 members, the committee possibly don't know every member. It was a good way to get some broader club member views.

One point that came out of it is that there are still some people that think Tukino costs us the most . That's possibly a historical perspective. Now with fixed charges; particularly for line charges for electricity, but

also rates, sewerage charges, and DOC fees and levies, it is Iwikau costing us the most at the moment. We haven't been differentiating between the lodges in terms of cost of stay, nor do we think we should start doing that, but until we do there will always be some kind of subsidy going one way or the other.

Thanks to Bonnie Kew for organising the survey, working out the questions, analysing the results and making sure that we as a committee look at it for planning the year and for the future.

And thanks to all of the committee for putting in the volunteer hours, again. (Anyone else who wants to help ... please make yourselves known!)

Accompanying this bulletin are the booking forms for this season. These may also be found on the club website www.aorangi.org under "Nightly Rates". Just click on the booking form and it will download as a word document. Save it and then fill it in and e-mail or post or fax it to the appropriate booking officer. If you wish a copy can be e-mailed or posted to you. Just contact John McGregor at jmcgreg@actrix.gen.nz and ask for a copy.

The RAL 2010 opening dates for Ruapehu are 19 June for Turoa and 26 June Whakapapa, snow permitting

All bookings must be made on the proper booking forms.

Please note the ages of children on the form. The trip leader will be upset if they find they have put a 6 year old on cooking duties!!

Also note arrival times, this gives people some idea of when to expect others coming in, and gives an indication if you want a meal if arriving early.

Remember the booking officers are NOT mind readers, so make an effort to fill in the booking forms with the correct dates and lodge you wish to stay at!!

All bookings must be paid for before staying in a lodge.

The small number of bad payers create the biggest amount of work.

Payment is preferably by cheque or direct credit to:-

Aorangi Ski Club, ANZ bank account, 010505 0085855 00.

If using direct credit please indicate whom it is from and what it is for.

If depositing the money into our account please send a copy of the deposit slip with the booking.

**Trying to sort out deposits when all that is stated on the bank statement is -
\$xxx.00 deposit 0505 – is like finding a needle in a haystack!!**

We can accept Visa or Mastercard but prefer cheques to credit cards as the credit card charges from May 2002 have increased. For instance if we have credit card banking between \$500 and \$2000 per month and the average ticket size is between \$50 and \$100 we can be charged 9% per ticket!! The highest charge is a massive 14%

The booking rules are also with this bulletin. They are also on the website. Please read them especially the procedure re cancellations!!! We do not refund booking fees if, for instance, you decide to go home if the weather is bad!!

But in saying this, if there is a very good reason for leaving, the committee is always reasonable.

Telephone bookings can only be made on Wednesday and Thursday nights between 7.30pm and 9.30pm for the next weekend. You may e-mail, or post your booking at any time.

Only fax bookings between 8.00 am and 10.00pm. The phone rings when a fax arrives and can wake the whole household if sent at 1.00am.

Please be reasonable with your phone calls!! We do not appreciate being rung at 7.30 in the morning or at 5.00pm when we've just arrived home from work and are trying to cook tea. E-mail enquires at any time; we access our e-mail at least once a day.

You **must** book in with the booking officer before arriving at a lodge. Don't just arrive on the mountain and hope to find a bed. It could also be dangerous, just imagine deciding to go up the Tukino road, getting stuck in the early hours of the morning and no one knows you are coming! It could prove fatal!

Remember that the booking officers have a life and like to go skiing as well. Especially mid-week. So please book early to avoid a last minute scramble, remember first in first served apart from school holidays when bunks will be balloted if necessary!

Iwikau Lodge

Your Iwikau subcommittee and helpers have been busy since last winter to bring you another great winter experience in the lodge. We will have run 9 work parties and over 40 people helped out (some several times). Sincere thanks to all those who took some time out of their busy life to contribute to the wonderful club facilities that we all enjoy. There has been a lot of work done in the kitchen to replace the old ovens with new commercial ovens. The dining room has seen a makeover, with fully refurbished chairs (a big job led by craftsman Terry Gray) and re painted wall wood panelling. The rest of the lodge has been cleaned and tidied. The careering committee led by Jan McGregor have toiled long hours to source, purchase, deliver and store the great selection of food that we all look forward to over the winter months.

The committee has also decided to install wireless broadband in the Iwikau and Ohakune lodges for this winter. This will make communication with the lodge for accommodation and catering more efficient, give a more reliable webcam at Iwikau, as well as allowing reasonable use by members to check their email, etc without tying up the fax / phone line.

The lodge has also been able to host some summer activity groups including walkers and mountain bike racers.

We have not yet been able to resolve the best way to reduce the unreasonably high power charges that are imposed on the consumers in the Ruapehu area. It may need political involvement to obtain a level of pricing that is fairer. The RMCA committee are keeping a watch on the developments in this area, and have been doing good work through the year providing coordinated and wise advice on a number of issues concerning the clubs on the mountain.

The custodians this winter will be Laura and Mike Hopkins sharing the job with Phil Shackel. Another great team bring you the warmth and good cheer that we have grown to appreciate in the lodge.

Again Jan McGregor, our lodge housekeeper worked constantly during the ski season (and during the summer break, catching bargains) to ensure that the pantry is well stocked and that we are buying from cheapest suppliers without sacrificing quality. Thank you Jan, for your dedication and hard work. And thanks to the kind members who have carried fresh vegetables from Levin to the mountain – you are really appreciated.

Thanks also to John and Jan McGregor for keeping the beds filled with their tireless (and often thankless) duty as booking officer – a multi-skilled job that may seem simple, but involves long hours of tedious work and diplomacy to produce the results we see. Please follow the simple booking rules to make their job easier.

BOOKINGS - Normal Bookings *open one calendar month ahead.* School Holiday Bookings *see below.*

PAYMENT All bookings MUST be paid for PRIOR to leaving for the mountain, preferably by cheque or direct credit to Aorangi Ski Club, ANZ account 010505 0085855 00.

TELEPHONE BOOKINGS for the next weekend will only be accepted on Wednesday and Thursday nights immediately preceding the weekend concerned.

BOOKINGS may be posted, faxed or e-mailed to the Booking Officer of the lodge you wish to stay at. Each booking period must be made on a separate form. Bookings for consecutive nights in one lodge in excess of seven nights will only be accepted if other applications for the bunks are not received within 3 days of the extended period. Booking forms may be faxed to the Booking Officer's fax number between 8.00am and 10.00pm any day. For payment of fees see above!

WEEKEND BOOKINGS

The committee have decided that weekend bookings will be for a minimum of two nights!!

If the Friday or Saturday night is part of a week booking that's counts as the two nights.

It was also decided that if a Friday or Saturday night was free by the Wednesday night preceding the weekend, that Friday or Saturday could be booked as a single night.

LODGE FEES

The following fees per bunk night are GST inclusive

Members

Senior \$30.00

Junior \$25.00

Child (10 years and under) \$20.00

Non-Members

Senior \$50.00

Junior (11 to 17 years incl.) \$40.00

Child (10 years and under) \$30.00

CREDIT CARD BOOKINGS WILL INCUR 6% BANK CREDIT CARD CHARGES!

Non-Active members rate is the same as for non-member rates - with a maximum of 2 nights accommodation per season. Those wishing to stay for more than 2 nights must upgrade to active membership.

Associate members have the same booking rights as full members

Group Booking Rate: (Minimum 10 people to qualify) \$45.00 per person per night.

School Groups: (Minimum 10 people to qualify) \$35.00 per person per night. (Senior or junior).

School Holidays

June/July Holidays - Friday July 2nd to Sunday July 18th.

Bookings open on June 1st. Member's beds will be allocated on receipt of bookings. Non-members bookings will be confirmed eight days prior to commencement of stay, if bunks are available.

September/October Holidays - Friday September 24th to Sunday October 10th.

Bookings open on August 2nd. Member's beds will be allocated on September 1st and will be confirmed by e-mail. If applications exceed bunks available the allocation will be decided by ballot. Non-Members bookings will be confirmed on September 10th if bunks are available.

Children's Bookings

- 1 All child/junior persons must be under the care and control of a parent or senior member for the whole of their stay. (This includes junior members eligible for senior status). The Booking Officers will not find sponsors for children but may be able to supply the names of members going to the Lodge.
2. A limit of 3 children/juniors per adult including the adult's own child/children applies.
3. All children under 4 years require committee approval to stay at Iwikau and Tukino Lodges.
4. Permission is not required for under 4 year olds at Ohakune but parents must always be considerate of other persons booking into the Lodge.

Non-Member Guests

- 1 All guests must be accompanied by the member who booked them in and that member is responsible for them in the Lodge.
2. Non-member bookings will not be confirmed until 8 days prior to the date booked. For School Holiday bookings refer to rules for School Holidays.

Cancellations

Normal booking cancellations must be made no later than 3 *days* before the booking is due to start. School holiday cancellations are required to be made 1 *week* prior to the date the booking commences.

A CANCELLATION FEE OF \$2.00 PER BUNK NIGHT WILL APPLY!

Transfer of Bookings: Transfers are not permitted from one person to another. Transfers between lodges are treated as cancellations and rebooking.

Refund of Fees:

1. If the required notice is given, the fees paid (less the cancellation fee of \$2 per night and any bank charges incurred) will be refunded by cheque on *written* application to the Committee.
2. Late cancellations, for whatever reason, are not eligible for refunds unless your bunk can be reallocated. The Committee will consider any written application on the merits of the individual case.

Failure to Book

Anyone arriving at the Lodge without a booking must first telephone the booking officer at their own expense to check on the availability of bunks and shall provide immediate payment by credit card. *Custodians and/or Trip Leaders are not authorised to accept or arrange bookings at any Lodge.*

Lodge Opening

In the interests of safety and economy Iwikau and Tukino Lodges require a minimum of 2 members to be present for the Lodge to open.

Equipment

A sleeping bag, pillowslip and towel are essential for all Lodges.

Your Committee promulgates these rules after much concern about being fair to all members. The Booking Officer has no authority to waive them so don't waste time asking. If you have a problem contact the Vice President for the Lodge in question. Do not hassle the Booking Officers.
